Coronavirus Update – Wealden

As of the 27th July there were 24 cases in our area, up 5 from the previous week. On the 26th July 2022, there were 82 persons in hospital with coronavirus. This shows a decrease of 21% compared to the previous 7 days. There was two deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test. Generally speaking, the case rate has reduced but we are still adopting a cautionary attitude, i.e.

1. **Hand Hygiene:** Do continue to use the hand sanitiser on arrival/departure.
2. **Singing:** It is not mandatory to wear a face mask in church or while singing but you may wish to continue the practice for the sake of those around you or where you may feel particularly vulnerable.
3. **Social Distancing:** All the pews are now open but please seat yourself at a respectful distance from those around you who are not part of your family group.
4. **Sharing the Peace:** During Holy Communion services we will stay in our places to share the Peace.

5. **Holy Communion:** will continue to be given in one kind only i.e. wafers, until case numbers have fallen to an acceptable level.

Live Streaming of Services (GDPR). In keeping with GDPR regulations if anyone would rather not appear in the on-line broadcast, please seat yourself in the pews at the rear half of the church.

Church Office Re-organisation – We plan a re-organisation of the church office over the coming months following the retirement of Chris Lawrence at the end of August. This will entail relocating the church office to the Vicar’s Vestry. We are looking for assistance in a number of capacities to ensure an orderly transition of support arrangements.
